Friday 7 February | Dubai to Doha

We arrive in the exciting capital city of Qatar in the mid-afternoon. After checking into the hotel, we enjoy a sunset cruise and dinner aboard a traditional wooden dhow, before finishing the evening with a walk along Doha Corniche, the city's waterfront promenade. Overnight Doha (B, D)

Saturday 8 February | Doha Museums

Today is a full-day tour of two spectacular museums. First, we visit the internationally-renowned Museum of Islamic Art, designed by the architect I.M. Pei and located on an artificial peninsula near the dhow harbour. Home to a diverse array of Islamic art from across the world, it showcases collections of ceramics, glass, metalwork, textiles and manuscripts. Next, we head to the stunning National Museum of Qatar. It was designed by Jean Nouvel who used the desert rose crystals found in Qatar as inspiration. The museum houses exhibits on the natural history of the desert and the Persian Gulf, Bedouin culture, the tribal wars, the establishment of the state of Qatar, and the discovery of oil. Returning to our hotel in the late afternoon, the evening is at leisure. Overnight Doha (B)

Sunday 9 February | Departure from Doha

After breakfast this morning, we transfer to the airport for connecting flights. (B)
